30 Jan 2019 7:00 PM - The Library, The Oriental Club, Stratford Place, W1

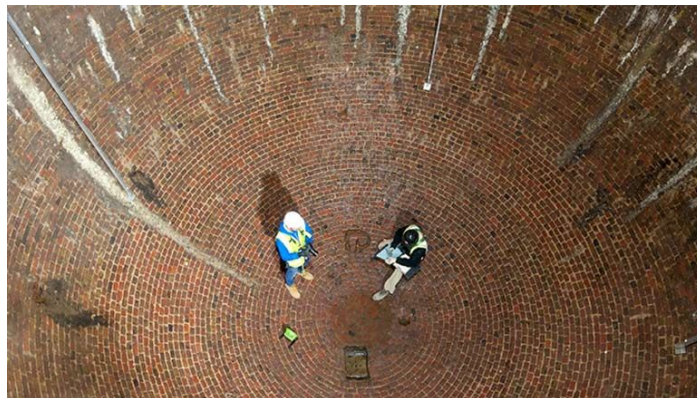
Join us for our annual wine & elegant canapés party and a chance to meet friends and neighbours and some of the committee members at the January Association get-together

Marylebone Ice House



A long-lost Ice House has been uncovered during building works under the Regent's Crescent in Marylebone. Ice Houses were underground chambers used to store ice and keep it cool in the years before modern refrigeration was invented. Ice was either taken from lakes, or later, imported from Scandinavia by boat, then then sold to be stored in the underground ice house. The huge underground Ice House dating from the 1780s has been recorded by buildings archaeologists from MOLA working on behalf of Great Marlborough Estates during the development of Regent's Crescent.
